THE MOUNTAIN RESORTS OF GEORGIA: RISING ABOVE IT ALL

There are few experiences that match the euphoria you feel when reaching the top of a ski lift. Suddenly, being on the top of the world, immersed in majestic beauty, embracing the biting fresh air, the mountains revealing their pristine ski slopes.

Here in Georgia we are blessed with some of the most impressive and highest mountains in Europe, with many peaks in the Caucasus Mountain Range surpassing Mont Blanc, including Mt. Shkhara (5201 meters), Mt. Mkinvartsveri (5054 meters), and Europe's tallest peak, Mt. Elbrus (5,642 meters).

But skiing here is more than just majestic mountains. Ongoing investments and upgrades have raised our traditional resorts of Gudauri and Bakuriani to international standards, while our brand new resorts Goderdzi and Mestia will be some of the most advanced resorts in the world.

New runs & high-speed lifts are being opened every year, but if skiing on piste (trails) isn't enough for you, Georgia is one of the few countries in the world that offers heli-skiing. All Georgia's ski areas are easily accessed with a modern contactless ticket system, SKIDATA, letting you experience all Georgian ski resorts with one ticket. The average price for a day pass is 40-50 Gel (\$12-\$15).

Soon the eyes of the world will be on the picturesque peaks here when Georgia hosts the 2023 Freestyle Ski and Snowboard World Championships.



SPLENDOR IN SVANETI

The Svaneti region of Georgia is a remote and beautiful area of historic fortified villages dating back to the 12-13th centuries, high mountains, breathtaking views, and few people. It is home to four of the ten highest peaks in the Caucasus, which are covered in a deep snow from December to April. Svaneti is where you'll find the community of Ushguli, one of the highest continuously occupied settlements in the world and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It is also home to the Mestia ski resort.

There are two ski areas in Mestia: Hatsvali and Tetnuldi, each offering you the feelings of bliss and excitement. Hatsvali is a forested ski destination with four ski lifts and 7 kilometers of ski runs. Tetnuldi has more of an alpine feel, offering five ski lifts and 12 kilometers of (trail) ski runs and unlimited off-piste opportunities. Here you also can try heli-skiing.

The resorts offer unique ski-tours, one or two day trips to take you to places that have never skied before, including overnight stays in the high mountains.


Before opening ski lifts, Mestia was a popular warm-weather trekking haven, so even in the off-season, it draws a crowd of happy visitors.



GUDAURI:

A RESORT FOR ALL SEASONS

Located in the very heart of the Caucasus Mountains, surrounded by some of Europe's most dramatic peaks, Gudauri is Georgia's largest and most popular ski resort.

Only a short drive (120 kilometers) from Tbilisi, Gudauri is Georgia's year-round playground. Ski season runs from December to mid-April, when the resort operates 18 lifts, four of which are gondolas, and offers 39 kilometers of ski pistes, with 17% of those boasting snow making capabilities.

Gudauri is situated on the south-facing plateau of Greater Caucasus at 2,000 meters above sea level (top elevation 3,276 meters). It offers a wide range of activities for families and skiers of all levels, including night skiing, heli-ski, snow park, ski tours, cross country skiing, and more. True experts may choose to take on some of the most challenging off-piste slopes in Europe.

The Gudauri Ski School employs English-speaking instructors, and provides lessons for beginners of any age. More advanced skiers can hire the instructors to serve as qualified backcountry guides and plan full ski trips for individuals or groups throughout Georgia.

The warm weather, off-season offers visitors spectacular hiking, trekking and even paragliding through the Caucasus.





BAKURIANI: SO MANY CHOICES

Located on the northern slope of the Trialeti Range, 180 kilometers to the north of the capital Tbilisi, at an altitude of 1,700 meters, Bakuriani is Georgia's first ski resort (1932), and home to legendary ski jumper Koba Tsakadze. Here you can enjoy Alpine ski runs, cross-country trails, horseback tours, sledding or simply take long walks through beautiful snowy forests.


Bakuriani is split into three ski areas: Didveli, Kokhta and Mitarbi. With a top station at 2,702 meters, Didveli has one of the most amazing views in any ski resort in the world. From here you can catch a gondola to ski intermediate and advanced slopes and experience night skiing on Nodo ski run. Advanced skiers can continue further up the mountain by catching a chairlift at the top of the gondola. Here you can embrace the challenge of very steep and difficult, advanced and expert ski runs.

Kokhta is perched at an altitude of 2,157 meters and is served by a six-pack chairlift with a middle station. This modern ski area boasts 3.1 kilometers of intermediate, advanced and expert pistes with unrestricted access to untouched powder.

Only four kilometers and one ski run (Kokhta-Mitarbi) away from Kokhta, the new Mitarbi ski area offers 7 pistes of all three skill levels (intermediate, advanced and expert), covering a total of 10 kilometers. Watch for Mitarbi to grow in the years ahead, as it is currently part of a large-scale development project, the Kokhta Mitarbi Resort, which will feature new hotels, cottages, restaurants and entertainment facilities to accommodate over 600 families.

In 2023, Bakuriani will truly spring to life, when it serves as the host city for the 2023 Freestyle Ski and Snowboard World Championships. And once again two years later, when it hosts the 2025 Winter European Youth Olympic Festival.

Situated in the middle of Bakuriani is Twenty-Fives, a ski area designed for beginners. Here, the mighty Caucasus Mountains create a safe and pleasant environment for beginners and children. You can also sled here, or embrace the romance of a horse drawn sleigh-ride through the ancient forest.

Bakuriani is a four-season resort with summer attractions such as mountain biking, hiking, horseback riding and more. When you want to share the feeling of amazement with your friends or family, Bakuriani awaits.


Fresh air, spectacular scenery and pristine mountain forests provide a feeling of tranquility every day of the year.





- “Multicard” is non-transferable. Violations will be subject to confiscation
- There is a 50% discount on a Seasonal “Multicard” after March 15, 2022
- A child age is up to the age of 18. Children under age of 6 can use any lifts for free

Visa Requirements

The visa policy of Georgia became comparatively liberal, allowing citizens of 98 countries to enter, reside, work and study in Georgia without the necessity to obtain either a visa or residence permit. In addition, the Georgian Government approved the list of 50 countries whose visa and/or residence permit holders may enter Georgia without a visa for an appropriate period and under appropriate conditions.

The climate of the country is extremely diverse. Average temperatures in summer range from 19°C to 22 °C, and in winter from 1.5 °C to 3 °C.

Electrical current - 220 volts, 50 Hz. EU standards plugs work throughout Georgia.

The currency in Georgia is the Georgian Lari. ATMs can be found in major towns and cities. Credit and debit cards are widely used in major cities.

The country code is +995. Georgia's mobile operators are present in most parts of the country, and there are many Wi-Fi zones that enable visitors to use the internet for free.
